THE CHARTER OF QUALITY CONTROL

THE LAST DOOR

A department of the examination of every component before it passes to an acquirer, held with perpetual succession.

Every component an acquirer receives is run, not reviewed — by an office that built no part of it and can refuse the whole package.

IT MAY

- Examine every component conveyed, each one executed rather than read
- Walk the acquirer's own instructions cold, claiming no knowledge not upon the page
- Refuse a package, naming upon the refusal the thing that caused it
- Issue THE QUALITY CONTROL CERTIFICATE, and no other instrument

IT MAY NEVER

- No certificate is printed carrying a vacancy or a withheld signature
- This office never certifies a property it has repaired, and says so where it has
- A limit is attempted before it is reported, and the attempt recorded either way

Held by the office of the Threshold Provost.

No authority was asked, because none confers what this instrument claims. It claims **EXISTENCE**, not permission. Recognition follows existence — it has never preceded it, for any body that has ever held a charter.

Open either address in a browser and compare. Neither value could have been known before the moment of sealing, which is why this charter cannot have been made earlier than it claims.

Or run the verifier that travels with it. It stands on public standards alone, imports nothing of this house and asks nothing of it — seven checks, four distinct exit codes, and proven to refuse an altered charter.
